

Michigan NOW Chapters to take ACTION in celebration of the anniversary of Roe v Wade

On Saturday afternoon, January 27 our Chapter will be picketing one of the two so-called "crisis pregnancy centers" (CPCs) in Washtenaw County: Arbor Woman on East Liberty or Family Life Services on Packard. The National Abortion Rights Action League (NARAL) defines CPCs as "fake health-care clinics that lie to, shame and intentionally mislead women about their reproductive-health-care options to block them from accessing abortion care." <u>Crisis PRegnancy Centers</u> Women facing an unintended pregnancy deserve medically accurate, comprehensive and unbiased information. Unfortunately, Michigan is one of 12 states that provide CPCs direct state funding, creating the false impression that they are part of the mainstream medical community -
